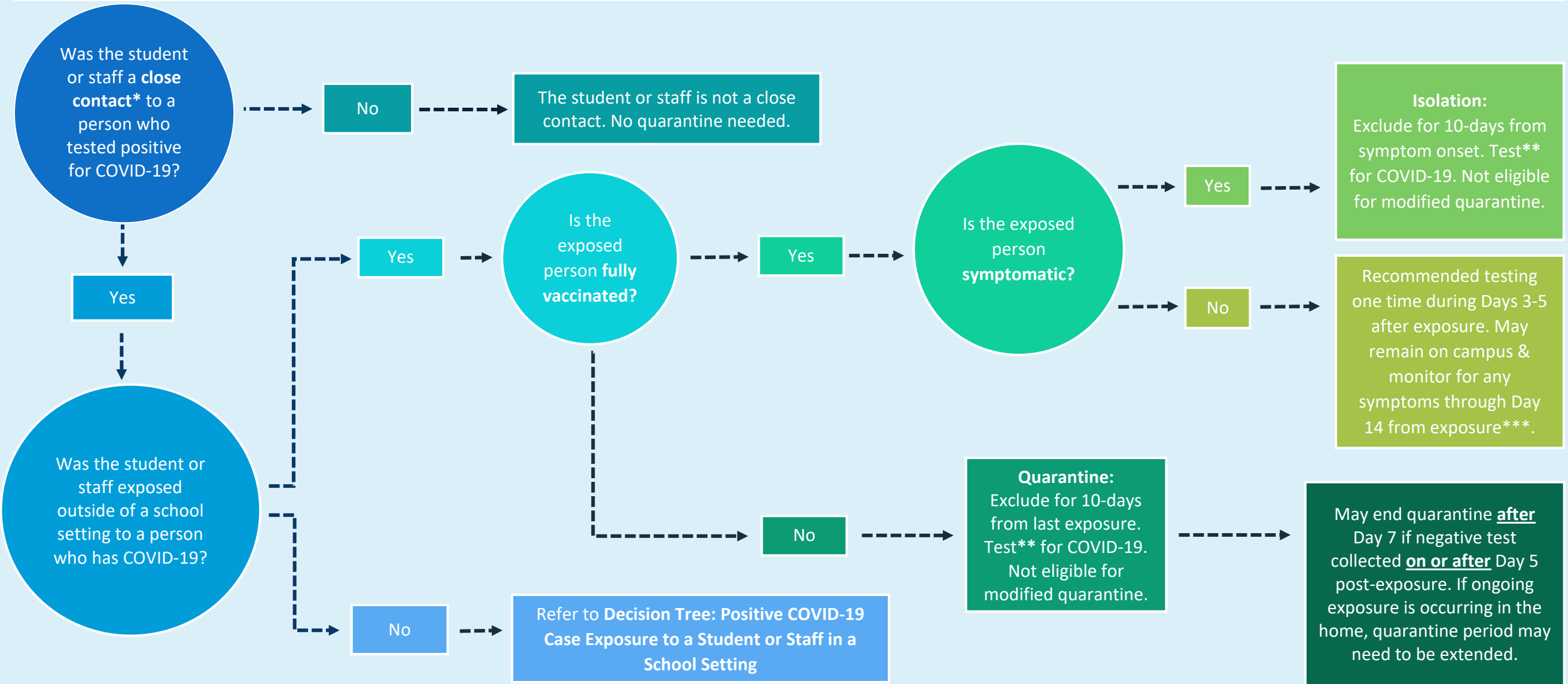


DECISION TREE: POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE EXPOSURE TO STUDENT OR STAFF OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL



*A close contact of a potentially infected person is a person who was in close contact in the last 2 days (more than 15 minutes over a 24-hour period within 0-6 feet) with a potentially infected person or had direct contact with bodily fluids/secretions from a potentially infected person.

PCR or Rapid Antigen Testing are acceptable testing methods. Over the counter Rapid Antigen, tests performed at home are not **acceptable as a testing method.

*** **Monitoring of Symptoms** begins immediately on Day 0 and **Day 1 of Quarantine** is the day after exposure date.
